Notes

In the third movement, the flute is tacet; the flautist plays a large African gourd shaker (Chekere).

Percussionist 1 plays Kit, comprising Bass Drum, Snare, Hi-hat, Rack Tom & Floor Tom.

Percussionist 2 plays Orchestral Bass Drum, one Timp (low F#), and a pair of African Cowbells (Gankogui).

In the third movement the Violins are divided into five sections (A-E), rather than into firsts and seconds.

The score was prepared using E-Magic **Logic 2.5** running on an 8Mb Apple Performa 475. Some notational inaccuracies are unavoidably present in the score, particularly in regard to the display of long notes in 12/8.

“How Two Minds...” was composed for the Napier University Chamber Orchestra, Dir. Margaret Murray-McLeod, and completed with the aid of a Creative Artist’s Bursary from the Scottish Arts council.
